 - **Parallel Service Roads in East Lake and Seminole Counties**
- **Connectivity to SR 417 and I-4 Corridors**



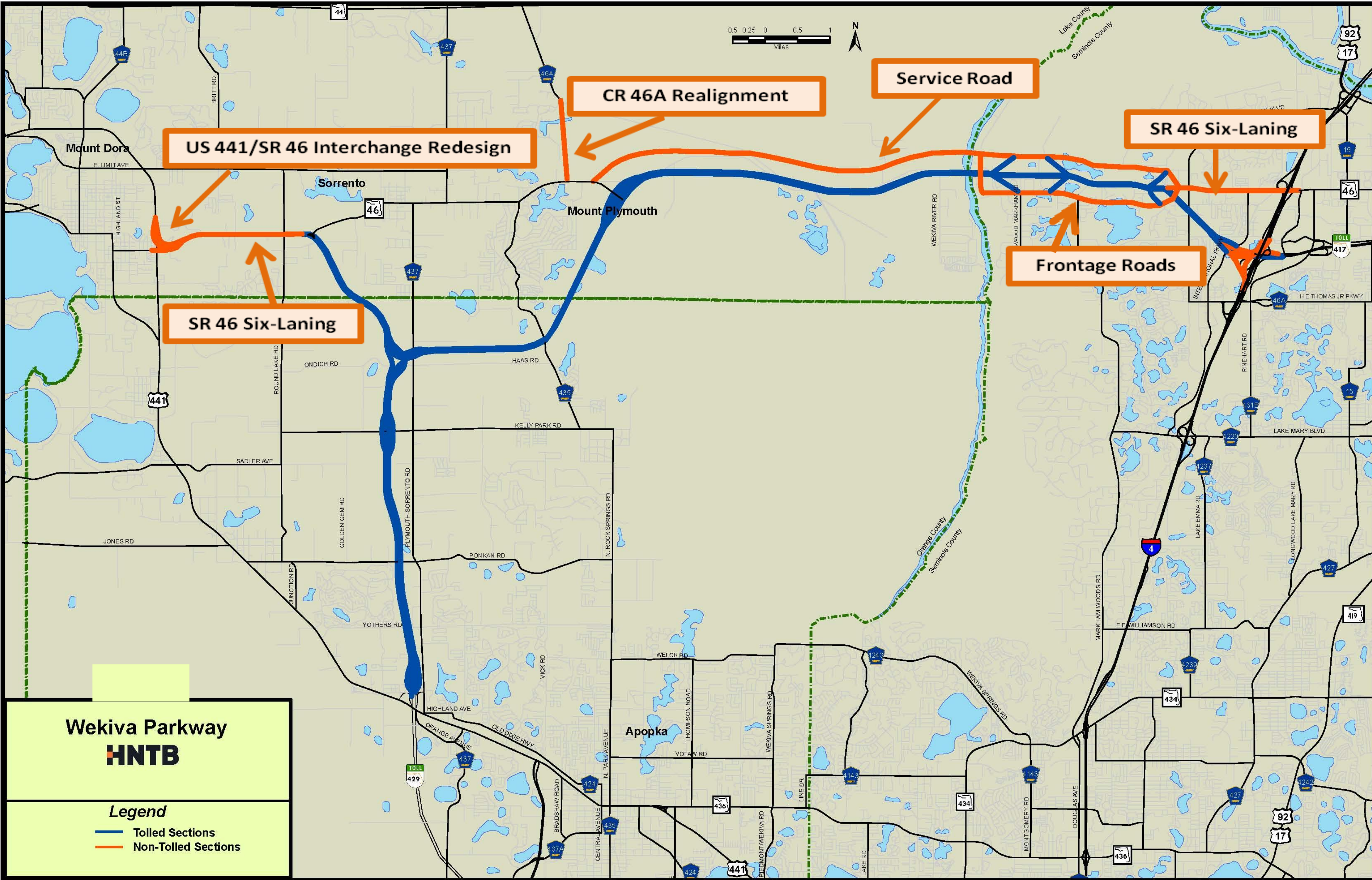

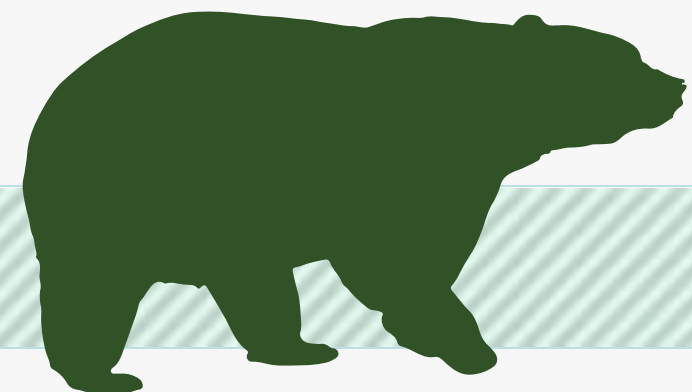
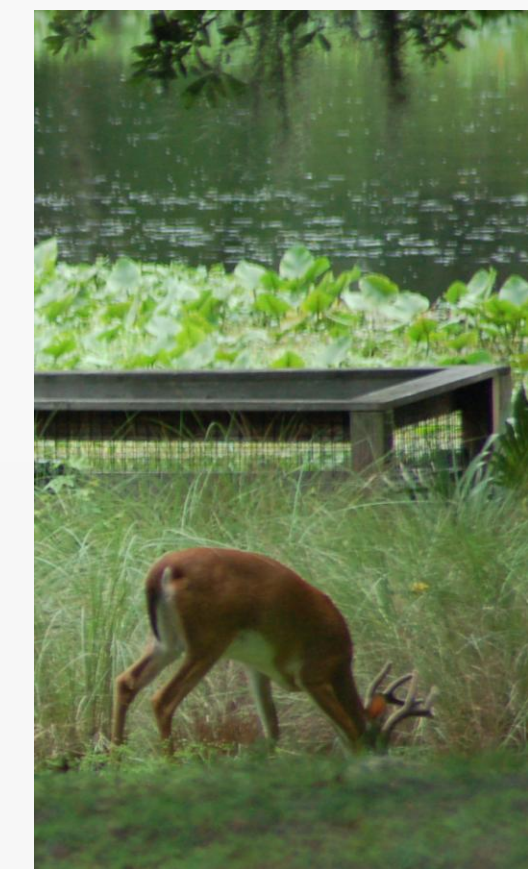
- **Wekiva River: Outstanding Florida Water & National Wild & Scenic River**

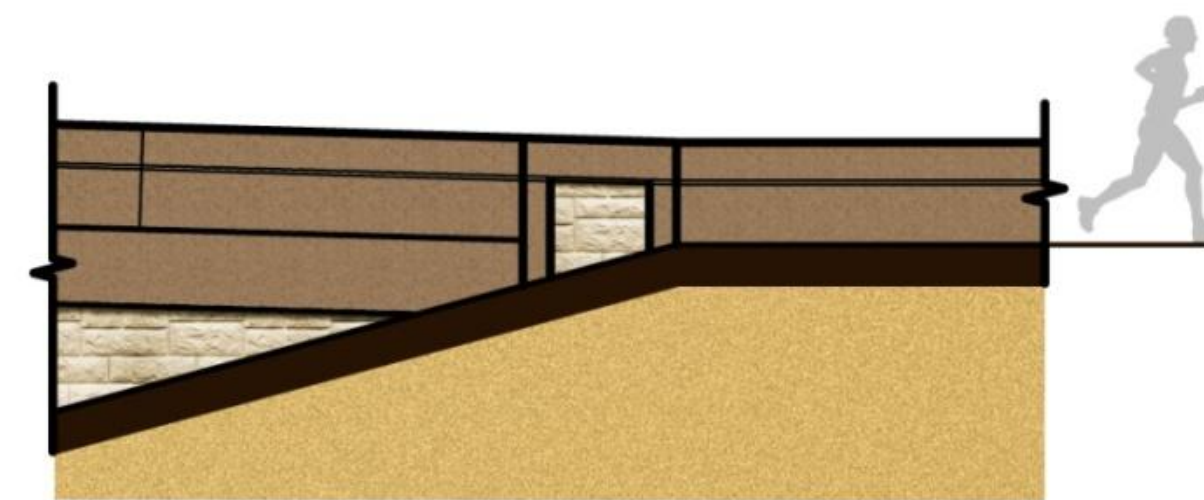

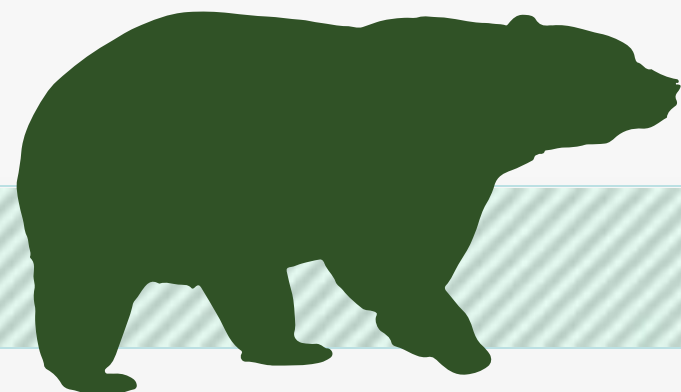
The Wekiva Parkway will be completed and **open to traffic** as follows:

- 2A, 2B & 2C – 2019

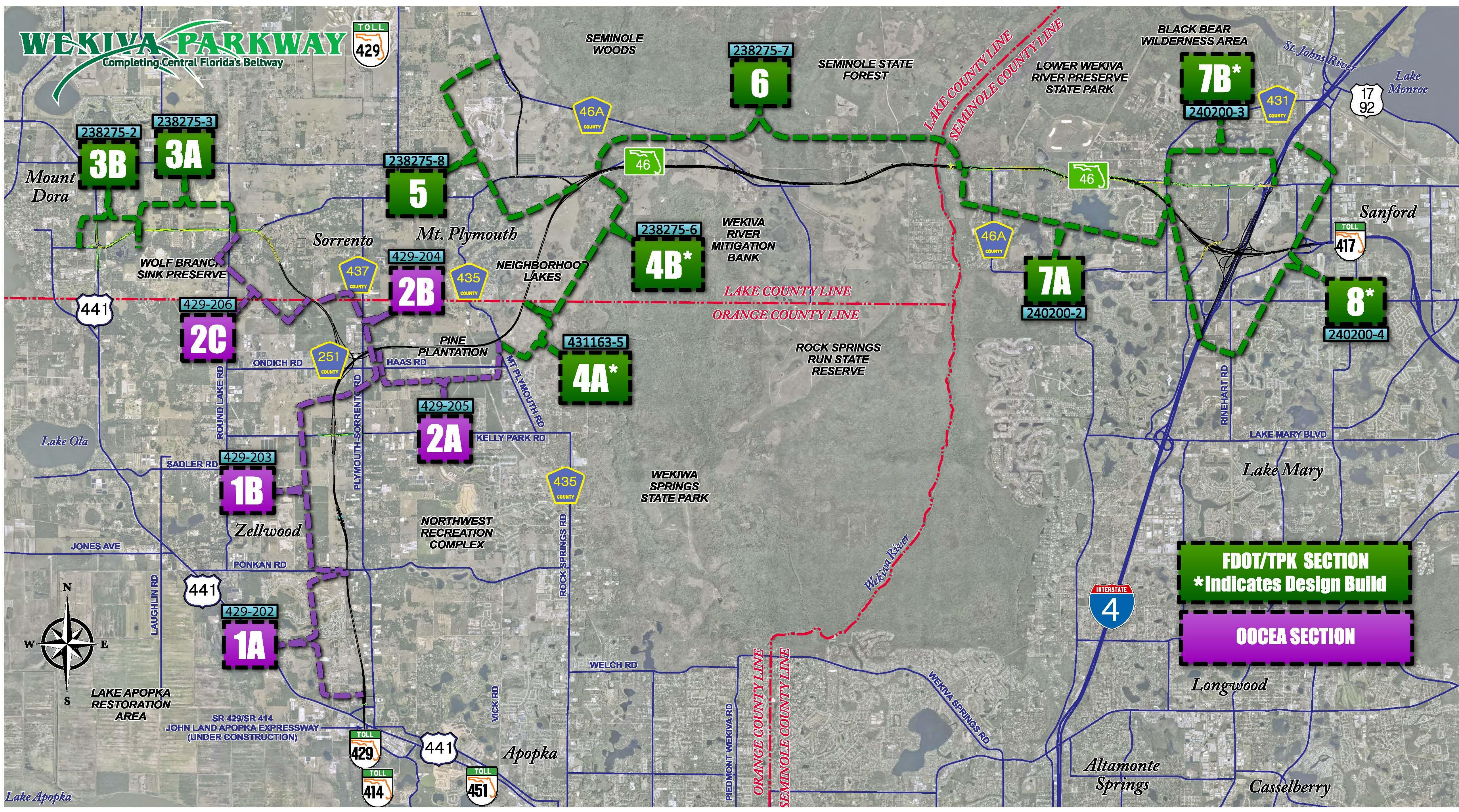

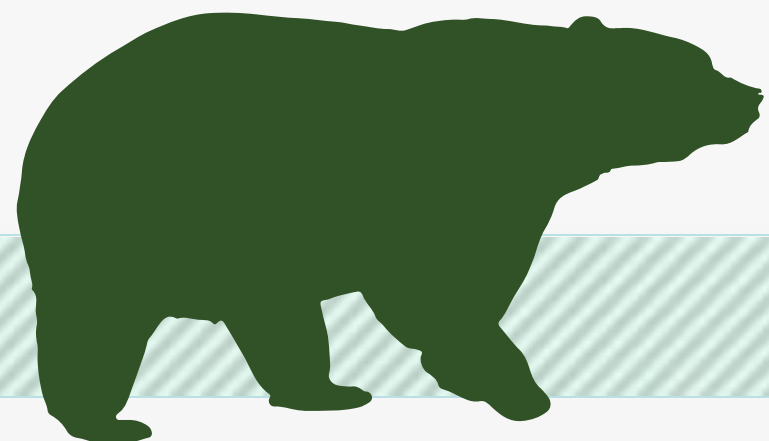
