

SECTION 8 (FPID No. 240200-4) PROJECT OVERVIEW

Project Limits: From Orange Boulevard, just south of State Road (SR) 46, to east of Rinehart

Road along SR 417

Project Length: 2.63 miles

Project Status: Preliminary Design

Project Schedule:

Right-of-Way Acquisition: November 2016 – March 2018

Advertise for Bids: January 2018

Design/Construction: October 2018-Late 2021

Design/Construction Cost: \$208 million

Section 8 Project Description: This design-build project involves an elevated, limited access toll road with an interchange at I-4 that will connect with SR 417. This will complete Central Florida's beltway. Work includes rebuilding part of I-4, and building or replacing 23 bridges. New interchange ramps will provide access to and from International Parkway. The current ramp from SR 417 to International Parkway also will remain.

Special Features: A toll gantry will be built on this section. The Wekiva Parkway will include all electronic tolling for the greatest customer convenience and to keep traffic moving. For information on toll costs, see the additional flier available at this meeting.

The parkway also will include aesthetic walls and other features.
