


Toll-By-Plate collects tolls by taking a photo of a vehicle's license plate as it travels through an FDOT tolling location. It then mails a monthly bill for the tolls, **plus a \$2.50** administrative charge, to the registered owner of the vehicle.

Protecting Nature

- Wekiva River: Outstanding Florida Water & National Wild & Scenic River
- Authorized: 2004 Wekiva Parkway & Protection Act
 - Setting Aside More than 3,400 Acres for Conservation
 - Largely Elevated to Reduce Accidents Between Vehicles & Wildlife
 - > Several Wildlife Bridges
 - ➤ Moving CR 46A Out of Seminole State Forest
 - > Limited Interchanges (Curb New Development)









Wekiva River Bridge - Profile



Section 8 Update - Schedule

- Right-of-Way Acquisition: November 2016 March 2018
 - Some Advanced Acquisition (Total Takes) Has Occurred
- Advertise for Bids: January-February 2018
- Design-build Project Begins: October 2018
- Open to Traffic: Late 2021 (Wekiva Parkway Complete)

Vibration / Damage Concerns:


- Property Owners: Take Pictures / Video of Home Interior & Exterior Prior to Construction (Baseline)

Noise Concerns:

- Noise is an Unavoidable Impact of Construction
- Advance Notification: Night Work, Pile Driving & Other Impacts

Wildlife Concerns:

- FDOT & Contractor: Follow State & Federal Wildlife Protection Guidelines
- Gopher Tortoise Relocation to a State-Licensed Recipient Site
