Top 12 Excavator DOs and DON'Ts - It's the LAW

- 1** Each excavator must **CALL 811** before you dig.
- 2** Wait the required time **BEFORE** digging.
- 3** Check Positive Response System **800-857-8057** or **sunshine811.com**
- 4** 2C Positive Response Requires notifying Florida Gas Transmission of Start Date and Time of Excavation.
- 5** **PROTECT** the marks.
- 6** Florida Gas Transmission Representative **MUST** be on site to monitor **any** excavation within 15' of it's Facilities.
- 7** **DIG SAFELY.**
- 8** Have your **LOCATE TICKET** on the job site.
- 9** **DON'T** use locate marks from another project.
- 10** **DON'T** assume facility depth.
- 11** Color of pipes **DOES NOT** indicate the type of utility.
- 12** Damaged gas line **CALL 911** then call **Florida Gas Transmission's**
