Access to Wekiva Pines and Bear Pond Drive Changing

Crews are scheduled January 18-19 to shift State Road (S.R.) 46 traffic onto the new service road bridge over the Wekiva River as part of building the Wekiva Parkway (S.R. 429). The traffic shift includes shifting local access to several communities along the corridor, including Wekiva Pines and homes located between 31243 S.R. 46 and 31435 S.R. 46. The traffic pattern changes will remain in place for months. The change will allow crews to remove the existing S.R. 46 bridge, allowing the construction of the remaining parkway bridges to progress.

Thru traffic on existing S.R. 46 near Wekiva Pines will be shifted to the south of the existing traffic pattern. The existing road remaining that is required for property access will be renamed Bear Pond Drive. Other parts of S.R. 46 near this location that are no longer needed will be removed. Access to old S.R. 46 (now known as Bear Pond Drive) will be via a short access road on the north side of the corridor. Lake County officials have been contacted to change the addresses from 31243 - 31435 S.R. 46 to Bear Pond Drive.
