



Access to Wekiva River Oaks Changing

Crews are scheduled January 18-19 to shift State Road (S.R.) 46 traffic onto the new service road bridge over the Wekiva River as part of building the Wekiva Parkway (S.R. 429). The traffic shift includes shifting local access to several communities along the corridor, including Wekiva Park Drive. The traffic pattern changes will remain in place for months. The change will allow crews to remove the existing S.R. 46 bridge, allowing the construction of the remaining parkway bridges to progress.

Residents exiting Wekiva River Oaks will drive under the service road bridge and come to a stop sign across from Wekiva Park Drive. Residents wanting to access S.R. 46 would then turn right and come to a stop sign at S.R. 46. Eastbound S.R. 46 will require a left turn. Westbound S.R. 46 will require a right turn.

Residents entering Wekiva River Oaks will make a right turn off S.R. 46 onto the extension of River Oaks Circle. Residents will then make a left turn and drive under the service road bridge to access their homes.
